Meal Planning Ideas for Student Travelers

(The following prices are in effect for October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.)

Disney Youth Programs offers prepaid dining options - helpful for students who are traveling without their families and also for families who like to have more items pre-paid before leaving home.

Youth Dining Card - a gift card/ debit card that may be used in all **Disney** restaurants in the **Disney** theme parks and resorts. You may set any amount of purchasing power for each card. We suggest that you give the students dining cards for 1 day at a time. If the cards are lost or stolen, they are not refundable. Dining cards are accepted only in Disney restaurants and cannot be used in merchandise shops.

We offer a **Breakfast Coupon** for use at the Value and Moderate Resort Food Courts at \$8.45 (\$9.00 with tax included). This coupon may be traded for the breakfast entree and beverage of your choice.

We also offer a **Lunch** or **Dinner Coupon** to be used at the resort Food Court as well as at Counter Service Restaurants in all 4 theme parks – at \$13.15 (\$14.00 with tax included). This coupon may be traded for 1 entree, 1 side dish, 1 beverage, and 1 dessert. Meal coupons and dining cards may be ordered along with your ticket order - 6 weeks prior to arrival.

Group Dining Events

You may want to consider including special dining events for the group. How about having breakfast in the **Animal Kingdom** and be first in line for **Expedition Everest!** (Approx \$21-\$25 per person) -or- a dinner at **Fantasmic** in the **Disney Hollywood Studios** would be fun!
